CHAMPIONSHIP RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Changing of dance partners are not allowed for the same event.
- 2. All competitors must attend rehearsals as requested by the Organiser.
- 3. All competitors must be present for their events on time. Latecomers will be disqualified.
- 4. The Organisers will not accept any liability, claims for injuries, damage or loss suffered by the competitors.
- 5. The judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entertained.
- 6. The Organiser reserves the right to change the order of events and related matters.
- 7. The Organiser reserves the right to reject any entries from anyone whose status is unclear.
- 8. The Organiser reserves the right to change/cancel the competition and/or any event without prior notice.
- 9. For all Events, partnerships with Professionals are not allowed. Professionals are defined as having competed in Professional Level DanceSport events prior to date of competition.
- 10. For Tertiary Events, BOTH participants MUST be from the SAME Institution. Mixed partnerships will be disqualified. Tertiary competitors must attach a copy of your student matriculation card together with their entry form.
- 11. Competitors in the Beginner named events must dance in accordance to the syllabus up to Gold level of UKA, ISTD and/or NATD.
- 12. Beginner competitors must be dressed in accordance to the competition dress code else they will be disqualified. Please refer to the Appendix on dress code.
- 13. Heel protectors MUST be worn by all ladies.
- 14. All Participants are deemed to have consented tda® for the usage of any photographs taken during the competition for publication within our social media, website etc.
- 15. A grouping system* for the various events will be implemented;
 - Group A Category V & Category IV Events Only
 - **Group B Category IV & Category III Events Only**
 - Group C Category III & Category II Events Only
 - **Group D Category II & Category I Events Only**
 - **Group E Category I & Category 0 Events Only**
 - **Group F** Solo Beginner Events, subjected to the age limits and 1 category above
 - **Group G** Solo Open Events, subjected to the age limits and 1 category above
 - * The Grouping System does not apply for Category I S, PD, VW, SF.

Competitors may only compete in events within their designated groups.

E.g. Group A Competitors are <u>NOT</u> permitted to compete in Category II Events

16. Age-Limited competitors are allowed to participate in their category and 1 category above.

Age limits, are as follows, based on calendar year of birth:

Youth 21 and Below

The older competitor must be born in Calendar Year 2003 to 2007.

Ju<mark>nior 16 and</mark> Below

The older competitor must be born in Calendar Year 2008 to 2011.

Juvenile 12 and Below

: The older competitor must be born in Calendar Year 2012 to 2014.

Juvenile 9 and Below

: The older competitor must be born in Calendar Year 2015 or above.

Solo 16 Yrs and Below

Competitor must be born in Calendar Year 2008 to 2011.

Solo 12 Yrs and Below

: Competitor must be born in Calendar Year 2012 to 2014.

Solo 9 Yrs and Below

Competitor must be born in Calendar Year 2015 to 2016.

Solo 7 Yrs and Below

Competitor must be born in Calendar Year 2017 and above.

TEAM MATCH (LATIN)

- 1. Each team is to consist of 6 members:
 - 2 x Soloists
 - 2 x Couples (4 competitors)
- 2. The Team Match will be an 8 dance event:
 - a. Cha Cha (Solo)
 - b. Cha Cha (Partner)
 - c. Samba (Solo)
 - d. Samba (Partner)
 - e. Rumba (Solo)
 - f. Rumba (Partner)
 - g. Jive (Solo)
 - h. Jive (Partner)

Each soloist and each couple must dance in 2 events. It is up to the team's discretion to select which soloist / couple will dance for each round.

- 3. Entry fee to register is **\$\$150** per team. This fee is **not** waived for tertiary participants.
- 4. Couples may also include girl-girl pairings.
- 5. Members of each team **need not** be from the same representing institution.
- 6. The Team Match may be cancelled in the event of insufficient team signups.

Appendix: Beginner Dress Code

(Solo & Partner Events)

Introduction

Beginner dress code are based on the following guiding principles:

- Professionalism: A stricter dress code establishes a professional standard in DanceSport
- Technique Focus: It allows beginner dancers and new competitors to be assessed on their technical and artistic ability, not dress.
- Equality and Accessibility: To keep the cost of entry as low as possible relative to the minimum standard of outfit required for competition.
- Tradition Respect: Adhering to the dress code honours DanceSport's tradition and heritage.
- Safety: It ensures dancers have appropriate attire for safety and functionality.

Ladies

Dress

Single colour plain dress with no sequins or gemstones

Decoration

No decoration allowed (rhinestones, sequins, feathers, fringe, lace applications, pearls etc)

Hairstyles

No diamantes, or similar, to be used on hair, hairpiece, clip or any other item in or on hair. Hair to be neatly tied in ponytails, bun, plaits etc.

Jewellery

Earrings, if worn, must be plain gold or silver studs, no evening dress earrings to be worn. No diamanté jewellery, bangles, necklaces to be worn.

Shoes

Ladies sandal, soles, and heels should be in good repair and not cause any damage to the dance floor. Heel protectors should be worn.

Gentlemen

Trousers and Shirt

White long sleeve shirt (tucked in), black trouser, with bow/tie.

Decoration

No decoration allowed (rhinestones, sequins, feathers, fringe, lace applications, pearls etc)

Hairstyles

Short hairstyle is preferred. If the hair is long, it has to be worn in a ponytail.

Jewellery

No jewellery allowed.

Shoes

Men's Shoes, heels, and soles should be in good repair and not cause any damage to the dance floor.

Tailcoats

No tailcoats allowed.
